**EMERGENCY ORDER DESIGNATING  
DEPUTY STATE COORDINATING OFFICER**

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2022, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 22-54 regarding the wildfire in Bay County and declared a state of emergency to protect the lives and property of the people in the threatened communities, the environment, and the general welfare of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2022, Governor DeSantis amended Executive Order 22-54 with Executive Order 22-55 to include Calhoun and Gulf counties in the state of emergency due to the development of additional wildfires; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 22-54 designated the Director of the Division of Emergency Management as the State Coordinating Officer and authorized the State Coordinating Officer to designate Deputy State Coordinating Officers, as necessary, for the duration of this emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KEVIN GUTHRIE, as the State Coordinating Officer, pursuant to Section 2 of Executive Order 22-54, hereby designate James Bujeda, Deputy Director of the Division of Emergency Management, as a Deputy State Coordinating Officer for the duration of this emergency.

This Order is effective immediately and shall remain in effect for the duration of Executive Order 22-54 and any extensions thereof.




